- Certificate or proof of completion of adult instructor methodology class
(*within the last 3-5 years*)

Incident Experience:

- Written Incident Action Plan (IAP) with documented position experience

- Colorado Application with applicable signatures
- FEMA 75-5 Application with dates of preferred attendance
(Please note there are 3 Rounds of training.)

The applicant's and head of sponsoring organization's signatures must be provided.

All experience and training MUST be documented and submitted with the application. We will not accept applications that do not demonstrate the training and experience to support the application. More documentation may be asked for if the experience is not clear.
