


## Accessing the Demographic Profile for a City, Town or Census Designated Place (CDP) in the NEW American FactFinder: Step-by-Step Directions

1. Start at the New American FactFinder homepage, [factfinder2.census.gov](http://factfinder2.census.gov)
2. Click on the blue **"Geographies"** button located on the left side of the page. This will open the Geographies overlay screen, allowing you to make your selections.
3. At the top of the overlay type the name of the Geography you're interested in into the box, and click "GO". *If the City, Town or CDP you're looking for appears in the list under "Geography Results", you can skip to Step 7. If it doesn't appear, or you're unsure of the spelling, please follow Steps 4 through 6.*
4. Under the header "Geography Filter Options", click on **"City or Town"**. It will be added to the "Your Geography Filters" box, and filters the geography options available to you.
5. Still under the header "Geography Filter Options", click on **"Within State"**, and choose **Colorado**. The Geography Results (main section of the overlay screen) now reflect Places (Cities, Towns and CDPs) within Colorado only.
6. Still under the header "Geography Filter Options", click on **"Within County"**, and choose the **County** your City, Town or CDP is located in. The Geography Results now reflect all Places within that county.
7. To select, simply click on the Place name (in blue text). If you want to open Demographic Profiles for multiple Places, you can check the box next to each name, and then click "Add".
8. The geography(ies) you've selected are now identified in the "Your Selections" box, and you should close the Geographies overlay screen by clicking the "x" at the top right.
9. You should now be back on the Search page. To access the Demographic Profile for your chosen Place(s), click on the title of the table DP-1, "Profile of General Population and Housing Characteristics: 2010".

10. Once the table is open you have the option to download the table. Simply click on the "Download" button, then choose your format (novice data users should select either Excel or PDF), and click "OK". The file will then be downloaded to your computer.
11. If you selected multiple Places, you can view each by using the "GEO" pull-down menu located at the top of the table.
