05-081	Otero County	Shredded tires to be used in Otero County's new public landfill. This is phase IV of the project. At least 80,000 waste tires will be used in this project.	\$80,000.00
05-082	City of Fort Morgan	Roadway surface crack seal through the City of Fort Morgan's residential streets within the City limits. Approximately 675 waste tires will be used in the product.	\$3,285.00
05-083	Mountain Valley School RE-1	Synthetic surfacing for the Mountain Valley Elementary School playground. Approximately 6,000 waste tires will be used in the product.	\$12,600.00
