To recognize National Lead Poisoning Prevention Week, Tri-County Health Department is offering free lead testing of personal and household items.

Lead in children, adults, and in houses has been recognized as a public health concern. Exposure to lead may occur through many household and occupational sources. The two most common pathways of exposure are ingestion and inhalation. Lead is a poison that affects every organ and system in the body. Very high levels of lead exposure can cause several major health effects.

Despite being banned in the United States, lead-based paints are still widely used in other countries and you may have it at home.
