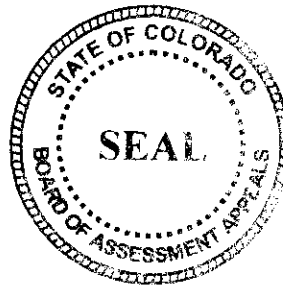

To equalize value with similar properties based on market data.


8. Both parties agree that the hearing scheduled before the Board of Assessment Appeals on June 30, 2008 at 8:30 AM be vacated.
