This information includes actual rent rolls, together with operating income and expense information of the property, which will be provided to the Assessor no later than March 15th of each year.
6. Petitioner(s) agrees to allow access to the improvements for the purposes of measuring or to obtain building condition information during normal business hours.
7. Petitioner(s) agree(s) to waive the right to a Board of Assessment Appeals hearing and any further appeal of the schedule numbers: 000729 for the assessment years covered by this Stipulation.
