Petitioner, Paula M. Mosle, and Respondent Pitkin County Board of Equalization hereby enter into this Stipulation regarding the tax year 2008 valuation of the subject property, and jointly move the Board of Assessment Appeals to enter its order based on this Stipulation.

The Petitioner and Respondent agree and stipulate as follows:

1. The property subject to this stipulation is described by metes and bounds, and is identified as Parcel No. 273512206015 in Pitkin County Assessor's Office records.
2. The County Assessor originally assigned the following actual value on the subject property for the tax year 2008:

Residential Land:	\$ 2,000,000
Residential Improvements:	\$ <u>503,600</u>
Total:	\$ 2,503,600

3. After a timely appeal to the Board of Equalization, the Board of Equalization valued the subject property as follows:

Total:	\$ 2,503,600

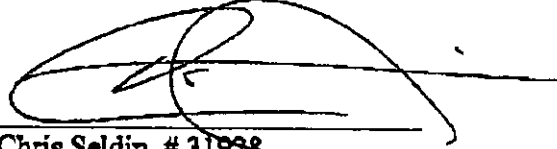
4. After further review and negotiation, the Petitioner and County Board of Equalization agree to the following tax year 2008 actual value for the subject property:

Total:	\$ 2,400,000

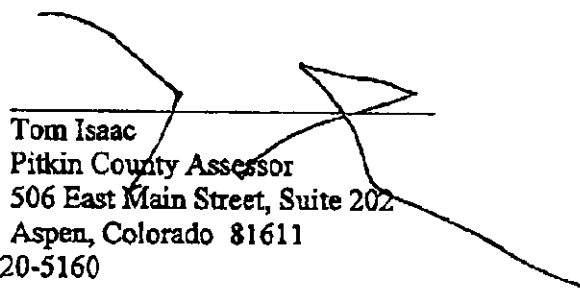
5. The valuation, as established above, shall be binding with respect to tax year 2008.

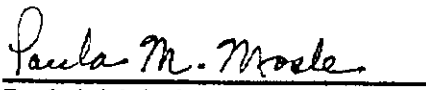
