

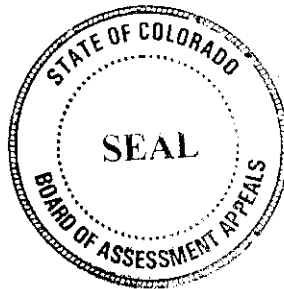

BOTH PARTIES stipulate and agree as follows:


1. The subject property is described by the following Jefferson County Property Schedule Number(s): 435589
