BOTH PARTIES stipulate and agree as follows:


1. The subject property is described by the following Jefferson County Property Schedule Number(s): 300216906

This information shall include, but not be limited to, actual rent rolls, together with operating income and expense information for the property, which will be provided to the Assessor no later than March 15th of each year.
5. Petitioner(s) agrees to allow access to the improvements for the purposes of measuring or to obtain building condition information during normal business hours.
6. This valuation is for purposes of settlement only and does not reflect an appraised value.
7. Petitioner(s) agree(s) to waive the right to any further appeal of schedule number(s): 300216906 for the assessment years(s) 2016.


